

Inkwater Author's Organization Mentioned in *Ocean's 13*

The summer blockbuster *Ocean's 13* has a surprise ending for at least one person: Inkwater Press author Lynn Price. She's the founder of Camp To Belong, a Colorado-based nonprofit that reunites siblings who are placed in separate foster care or other out-of-home care and provides leadership for the Sibling Connection Initiative.

In the last ten minutes of the blockbuster, George Clooney informs Andy Garcia that the \$72 million he owes him has been donated to Camp to Belong. Grudgingly, Garcia's character assumes the thrust-upon role of philanthropist, and he later appears on Oprah to take credit for the donation. In real life, Price, an Ashoka Fellow, is the recipient of the Oprah's Angel Network "Use Your Life" award, as well as many other prestigious accolades.

Price's first book, *Real Belonging*, focuses on her personal experiences, including a childhood in foster care, her later entrepreneurial success and the founding of Camp To Belong. Her second book, *Vision For A Change, A Social Entrepreneur's Insights From the Heart*, is an encouraging call to action for anyone with mind for business and a compassionate heart.
